The successful candidate will be responsible for directing, planning, organizing, and managing investigative and investigative support staff responsible for conducting criminal, civil, and special investigations for the Pima County Attorney.

The candidate will report directly to the Pima County Attorney and will consult with the Chief Deputy County Attorney and senior level executive staff. The candidate will represent the County Attorney at various law enforcement and civic functions and at local and state governmental committees and boards.

Required Qualifications: A Bachelor's degree (Master's degree preferred) from an accredited college or university in criminal justice or other related field; and ten years of experience as a full-time sworn law enforcement officer, including a minimum of five years investigative responsibility as primary duty (investigative experience in the course of other routine law enforcement duties is not qualifying experience); and a minimum of at least ten years of experience in a supervisory capacity.

Other Requirements: Candidate must possess current (AZPOST) Peace Officer Certification in Arizona. Failure to maintain the required licensure/certification shall be grounds for termination. An Arizona Driver's Class D License is required at time of appointment and must be maintained as a condition of employment.

Special Notice Items: This is an unclassified position exempt from the Pima County Merit System Rules.

Desired Qualifications:

- Previous Chief Investigator-level experience including management of detectives and support staff;
- Prior experience directing, conducting, and managing criminal, civil, and special investigations;
- Prior experience working with other federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies;
- Prior experience in conducting, preparing, and presenting confidential investigations and presentations to executive-level management.
