

Pima County Anti-Racketeering Revolving Fund

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Will funding be a single award or cost-reimbursement?

- a. Funding awarded will be per approved application, for upcoming projects and programs. Cost-reimbursement for previously funded projects or programs that have already occurred is not permitted.
- 2. If funded, what are the reporting requirements, if any?
 - a. Please consult with your organization's tax or financial advisor. Retain receipts for any expenses paid with ARRF funds.

3. What is the format for proposals?

a. Proposals submitted on the application provided by the Pima County Attorney's Office will be considered for an award.

4. What requests for funds are permitted?

- a. The Pima County Attorney's Office as well as other law enforcement agencies in Arizona, provide grant funding to community-based programs in Pima County whose missions are supportive of and consistent with a law enforcement effort, policy, or initiative, pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-2314.03, A.R.S. § 13-4315, and/or federal law.
- b. Cash gifts, gift certificates, food, beverages, creation of scholarships are NOT permitted.
- c. Funding priorities for this cycle are:
 - Initiatives that focus on second chance or vulnerable population housing and protecting elderly residents from the effects of crime
 - Initiatives that focus on overdose prevention and Narcan distribution
 - Initiatives for youth engagement and efforts to cut into the schoolto-prison pipeline.

5. How many times can you apply?

a. Applications and organizations will be considered for an award once per grant cycle

6. Were there the same funding priorities in previous years?

a. Funding priorities are set by the presiding County Attorney for each cycle and are subject to change.

7. Can funding be used for staff/personnel?

a. Proposals should focus on the funding initiatives announced per grant cycle and be limited to program expenses outside of personnel costs.
